

This programme gives access to more than **6,000+ e-journals** and more than **1,99,500+ ebooks** under N-LIST and **6,00,000 ebooks through NDLI** as mentioned on the N-LIST Website.





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

Death: An Inside Story, by Sadhguru (Jagadish Vasudev), Penguin Ananda , 2020, Paperback, ISBN – 978-0-143-45083-2 , 376 pages, Rs. 299/-

Conversations about death are a taboo in most societies in the world. But what if we have got this completely wrong? What if death was not the catastrophe it is made out to be but an essential aspect of life, rife with spiritual possibilities for transcendence? For the first time, someone is saying just that.

In this unique treatise-like exposition, Sadhguru dwells extensively upon his inner experience as he expounds on the more profound aspects of death that are rarely spoken about. From a practical standpoint, he elaborates on what preparations one can make for one's death, how best we can assist someone who is dying and how we can continue to support their journey even after death.

This book provides a rigorous introduction to the basics aspect group theory. In addition to the conventional group theory, the book introduces SageMath, a free open source computer algebra system based on Python programming language. The book is in parts. The book contains many illustrative examples and exercises to help the reader to critically analyse appreciate various concepts in group theory. The second part is an attempt to demonstrate SageMath can be used as an effective tool to understand computational aspects of group theory.
