

Participants Analysis:


Students: 102 (Males - 26, Females - 76)







Why We Sleep - The New Science of Sleep and Dreams, by Matthew Walker, Publisher: Penguin India, New Delhi, 2018, Paperback, ISBN: 978-0141983769, 368 pages, Rs. 599/-

Sleep is one of the most important aspects of our life, health and longevity and yet it is increasingly neglected in twenty-first-century society, with devastating consequences: every major disease in the developed world - Alzheimer's, cancer, obesity, diabetes - has very strong causal links to deficient sleep.

In this book, the first of its kind written by a scientific expert, Professor Matthew Walker explores twenty years of cutting-edge research to solve the mystery of why sleep matters. Looking at creatures from across the animal kingdom as well as major human studies, Why We Sleep delves into everything from what really happens during REM sleep to how caffeine and alcohol affect sleep and why our sleep patterns change across a lifetime, transforming our appreciation of the extraordinary phenomenon that safeguards our existence.

Deep Learning, by Ian Goodfellow, Yoshua Bengio and Aaron Courville, Publisher: The MIT Press, Cambridge, 2016, Hardbound, ISBN: 978-0-262-03561-3, 800 pages, Rs. 8,520/-

Deep learning is a form of machine learning that enables computers to learn from experience and understand the world in terms of a hierarchy of concepts. The text offers mathematical and conceptual background, covering relevant concepts in linear algebra, probability theory and information theory, numerical computation, and machine learning. It describes deep learning techniques used by practitioners in industry, including deep feed forward networks, regularization, optimization algorithms, convolutional networks, sequence modeling, and practical methodology; and it surveys such applications as natural language processing, speech recognition, computer vision, online recommendation systems, bioinformatics, and videogames. Finally, the book offers research perspectives, covering such theoretical topics as linear factor models, autoencoders, representation learning, structured probabilistic models, Monte Carlo methods, the partition function, approximate inference, and deep generative models.

Artificial Intelligence (2nd Ed.) by Saroj Kaushik, Publisher: Cengage Learnng India Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi, 2023, Paperback, ISBN: 978-93-5573-042-8, 677 pages, Rs. 799/-

This second edition is designed to provide comprehensive material for undergraduate and graduate students on the vast and fast-growing subject of Artificial Intelligence. This book has been written keeping in mind the syllabi designed for courses on Al in various technical institutions and universities in India and abroad. It can serve as a textbook for one full-semester course on Al. It will also provide study material to computer professionals who wish to expand their knowledge on Al.

The main topics covered in the book include problem-solving using intelligent searches and planning, knowledge representation techniques, game playing, first-order predicate logic and programming language PROLOG (programming in logic), uncertainty handling, expert systems, knowledge representation, etc. The language PROLOG has been used throughout the book which helps user to code programs for problems using Al techniques with a clear understanding of underline and natural thought processes of human ways of solving problems.
