



Business Intelligence: Data Mining and Optimization for Decision Making by **Carlo Vercellis**, Publisher: Wiley India Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi, 2018, Paperback, ISBN 978-81-265-4188-1, 440 pages, Rs. 619/-

From the Preface of the Book – "....The interpretation of the term business intelligence that we have illustrated and that we intend to develop in the book is much broader and deeper compared to the narrow meaning publicized over the last few years by many software vendors and information technology magazines. According to this latter vision, business intelligence methodologies are reduced to electronic tools for querying, visualization and reporting, mainly for accounting and control purposes. Of course, no one can deny that rapid access to information is an invaluable tool for decision makers......"



Written in an accessible manner, the book provides real-world examples and case studies to help readers understand the practical applications of the presented material. The book begins by outlining the legal requirements for data security, which synthesizes the Federal Trade Commission's cyber security cases in order to provide the background of the FTC's views on data security. The book also examines data security requirements imposed by a growing number of state legislatures and private litigation arising from data breaches. Anti-hacking laws, such as the federal Computer Fraud and Abuse Act, Economic Espionage Act, and the Digital Millennium Copyright Act, and how companies are able to fight cybercriminals while ensuring compliance with the U.S. Constitution and statutes are discussed thoroughly.
